

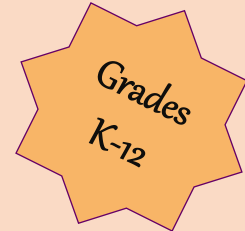
Homeschooling? Let us help!

- ✓ What grades do you serve? *MVCS works with grades K-12.*

- ✓ Can my high school student take classes at WCCC or CMU? *Yes—qualifying students take these classes for free, getting both high school and college credit.*
- ✓ Do you enroll any students full-time? *Yes. Students in grades 6-12 may enroll full-time and still enjoy the flexibility of only attending class 2½ days a week.*
